Monthly Safety Training



REDUCE YOUR SPEED.

Reducing speed increases traction and the ability to react to conditions around you.

AVOID THOSE RUTS.

Do not drive in the ruts of other vehicles. These areas of packed snow and ice have less traction than fresh snow.

DON'T USE CRUISE CONTROL.

If the vehicle's wheels lose traction on icy or wet roads and start to spin, cruise control can keep accelerating. Snow, ice, and road salt can interfere with sensors that manage adaptive cruise control.

WATCH THAT DISTANCE.

Keep a safe distance from the vehicle in front of you during hazardous weather. A rule of thumb for following distance for a truck is 7-14 seconds. Trucks need 40% more stopping time.

AVOID UNSAFE CONDITIONS.

Make the decision to shut it down during unsafe weather conditions. Communicate this with your dispatch team.
